How the Lord Used Us in October, 2022

Brothers and Sisters,

We were blessed to have completed 9 M.A.D. Live Events in October, bringing back memories of the old days when we had busy months like this every month. We equipped another 357 people to share their faith in Christ as a lifestyle and we were blessed to see the Lord save two men, including a Mormon at one of our events. Another man who is a Chaplain at a large hospital, told me that my training will impact how he does his job going forward. Glory to God! We were blessed to have partnered with WGRC radio in Lewisburg, PA to host 2 events for their listeners. Things normally slow down leading up to the holidays in November and December, and our schedule going forward mirrors that history.

To update you on our ministry truck situation, it does need a whole new engine. It catastrophically failed at 90,000 miles only 1 1/2 months out of warranty. Ford will not cover it. The cost to replace the engine is \$14,650. We had a local repair shop order the engine and the supplier shipped the wrong one. Then our shop found out that there are NO 6.7L diesel engines available anywhere in the US due to supply chain issues. He couldn't even tell me when he could get an engine, but it will be many months. There is a class action lawsuit about these failures, and Ford and Chevy are both being sued. I am trying to figure out how to get involved in it. In the meantime, we have no vehicle for ministry use, and at some point, a large expense for a new engine. As we have some down time right now with no trainings, I was hoping to do some off-road ministry during this slow time, but that can't happen without a truck to tow our machine to the trails. If the Lord leads you to help us with the expense, we'd be blessed! Prayers for the finances and a solution are always appreciated!



To update you on my son-in-law's horrific motorcycle accident, he is making amazing progress in healing, although it will be a long road. Your continued prayers and financial support are needed and are a huge blessing to them. Thank you!
