Greetings Brothers and Sisters!

We completed 3 MAD Live Events in August and I was blessed to share our ministry with 3 groups of kids at the Child Evangelism Fellowship Camp in Laureldale, PA (Berks County). I spoke to the kids about what it meant for every follower of Christ to be a full-time Ambassador for Him, what the qualifications were, and how to do it. I then contrasted being an Ambassador to being a full-time vocational missionary, also discussing the qualifications and the necessity of being “called of the Lord” to do this work as a vocation. I shared the Gospel with each group of young people and gave them an opportunity to respond in repentance and faith.

We trained 205 people at our MAD Live Events in August and continued to work to fill the calendar. Also this month, my friend, brother-in-the Lord, and riding buddy, Larry, and I again ventured a few hours southwest to Windrock Park to attend the annual hill climbing championships. We were able to share the Gospel with the people whom God connected us with and rode some of the trails. The temperature was 90 degrees with a 100-degree heat index and virtually no wind. Unlike the rainy weather last year, the ground was parched, so dust flew and hung in the air as every competitor attempted to climb the crazy steep hills (cliffs). They had to wait minutes between runs to let the clouds of dust dissipate so the drivers could see where they were going. The A/C in our RV broke on our way back from NH last month so we had no air conditioning. Thankfully, it cooled down in the evening and with the assistance of 2 fans, we were able to sleep in relative comfort.

FYI...We put our home up for sale as we need more room. Right now, the ministry RV cannot be kept at our house as the driveway entrance is too steep. The RV bottoms out when entering the driveway. Our church blessed us with the ability to park it at our Food Pantry, although it must be moved twice a month when the food pantry is distributing food to those in need. When we are departing on or returning from a trip, the RV has to be parked on the road facing the wrong way, and we must make multiple trips down the driveway with the car to load and unload the food, clothing, and ministry materials. I can’t fill the freshwater tank, wash or wax the exterior, or vacuum the inside of the RV as it sits down in the street. We thank God for someone who has given us a contract to purchase our house, contingent on them selling their house in Castle Rock, CO. We have a contract on a home about 16 miles from where we live now, pending the sale in CO. Prayers for everything to work out are appreciated!
