June 2024 - Monthly Report

Hello Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We completed 7 M.A.D. Live Events in June, bringing our total to 781 completed events. Glory to God! It will be so exciting to hear how the Lord used the almost 43,000 people that we've trained when we get to glory! I was blessed to have 49 Divine appointments this month and I shared the Gospel and some Gospel literature with these people. The Holy Spirit will finish the work! Occasionally, God gives us a glimpse of what He is doing. We received several very exciting testimonies this month. Praise the Lord with us!

"I was at your live event on Saturday at Clintondale Christian Church. I have been to many evangelism classes but was pleasantly surprised to have experienced so much more! This one is from a 72-year-old lady from NY State: "Good morning! Although you don't know me personally, you were at QHBC some weeks ago with one of your seminars. It was truly wonderful -- both my husband and I were deeply affected. I have more to say now about my recent experience in handing out "rescuer tracts" (I love how you said we should consider our reaching out to others for Christ as rescuing rather than witnessing). I wanted a good supply of tracts because what better field to reach out for Christ than at a cancer center? People there in such hopeless conditions, etc. I received the tracts --- and since then, on June 18th, my husband and I went up to Buffalo to the Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center with my sister (btw: my sister, Donna, is a widow and has no family around her -- we are nearly 3 hours away. She is counting on me to be with her through this journey for sure). We went to that appt. to find out the results of a biopsy and found out she has lung cancer. Now, more tests --- MRI next week, PET scan right after and then a July 3rd appt. for meeting with lung cancer specialist and so on.

Anyway, what I really want to get to is to tell you about what transpired with my "rescue" attempts. When it was time for Donna to get blood drawn, we had to go to the phlebotomy area which has a long hallway with cushioned benches on both sides of this hallway where all those waiting to have blood drawn sit. Each one is given a number to go in and get blood drawn. I prayed "Well, Lord, I really know you want me to start distributing tracts to all these people sitting here waiting and if I don't, then I am disobeying You". I just stood right up with tracts in hand (At that time, I used the one with an eagle and American flag on front about FREEDOM). I started at one end and came back on the other --- to each one I said, "hello, I'd like to give you something that has made such a difference in my life" and every single one of them, some of them couples --- smiled at me, thanked me and accepted them. Then when I sat back down a woman on my right, asked me, "what denomination are you?" I said, Well, I attend a Baptist church, however, what I am is a Bible-believing Christian, I love Jesus." She said --- so am I! Her husband got called in to get his blood drawn right then and I told her how we just found out my sister has lung cancer and right then my sister got called in. This woman,

her name is Darlene, asked, "May I pray with you?" And, certainly I was most thankful for that!! She prayed the nicest prayer and it was wonderful. We left soon after that.

Out in the parking lot, a parking attendant (happened to be a young black man) opened the car door for me and my sister had a few dollars for a tip which I placed on top of the tract "Ticket to Heaven" which I handed him. Great big smile from him and a thank you. As he walked away, he was reading it!!! And he kept reading it !! I saw him look up a few times to make sure he was walking in the right direction or whatever, and then he kept reading. I don't know his name, but I've been praying for each of these people who accepted the tracts. And I am very uplifted that even in the midst of the curse of cancer and the unpleasant things ahead, the opportunities I have to serve my Savior in this way, and particularly in that place (because I know we'll be going there again and again) are golden.

This is SO long --- but maybe you'll be able to get through it. I think you should hear about these things though because they are just some more examples of the fruit, the abundant fruit, of your ministry!! THANK YOU. God bless you!!"
